

# HAPPY SCRAPPY BABY QUILT 44" X 60"

A Bonus Pattern  
from Everyday Stitches

This quilt is designed to use the scraps from our *Gateway* quilt pattern.

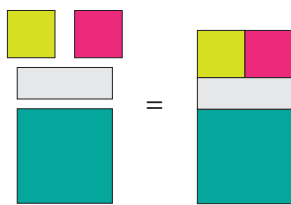

## Fabric Requirements

Large variety of colorful scraps  
2/3 yard of accent color

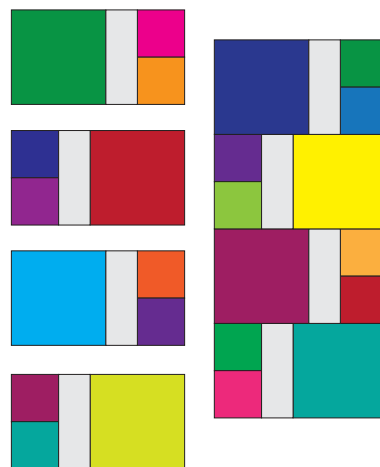

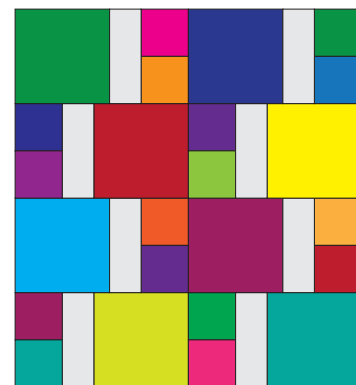


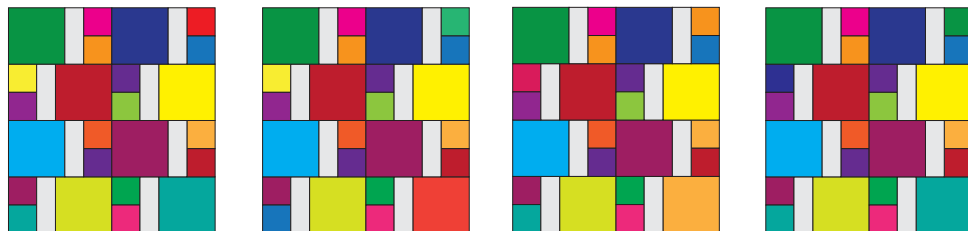
Diagram 3  
Block Finishes at 11" x 12"

## Cutting

From the scraps, cut:  
160 - 3-1/2" squares  
320 - 2" squares

From the accent fabric (shown in white),  
cut:

14-15 strips 1-1/2" x wof  
subcut each strip into 12 rectangles  
1-1/2" x 3-1/2" (160 total)



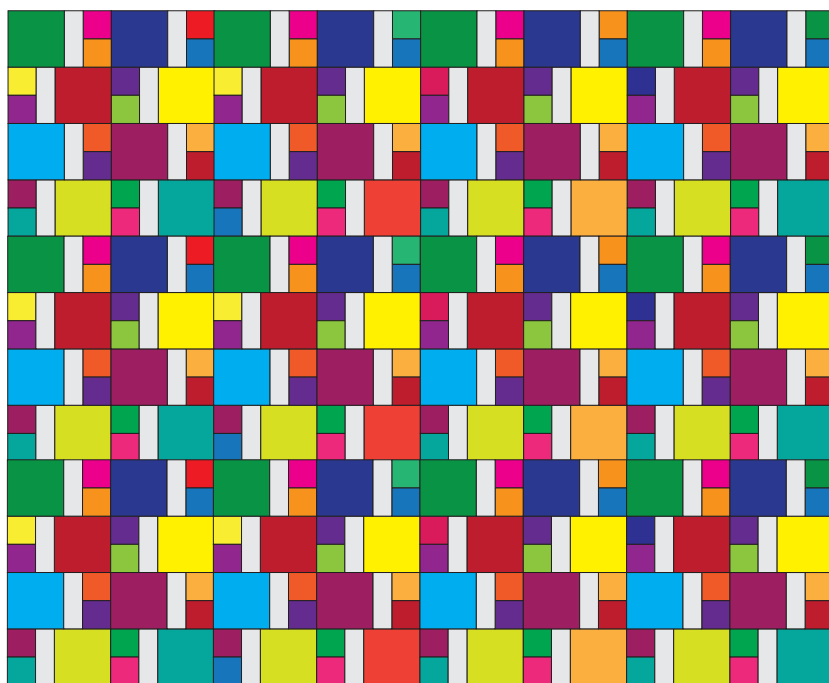
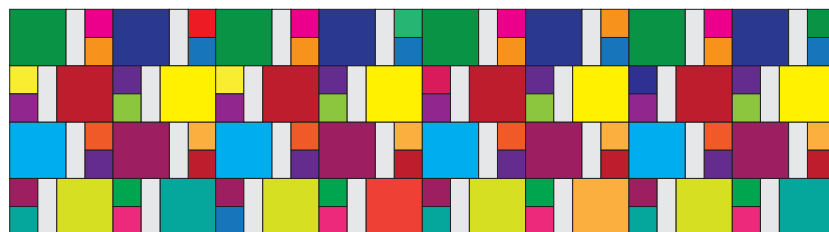
## Piecing

Sew two 2" squares together and press.  
Sew an accent fabric rectangle to a 3-1/2" square and press. Sew together as shown in Diagram 1 to make the block units.

Join 8 block units together as shown in Diagram 2 to make the 11" x 12" finished block, Diagram 3.

## Finishing

Sew the blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks each.  
Join the rows to finish. Quilt as desired and bind.
